- For any warranty claim placed within the 1st year, StandDesk will cover the cost of the part, shipping & handling. After the 1st year, StandDesk will cover the cost of the part, the customer will be responsible for the market rate shipping and handling costs.

WHAT IS NOT COVERED BY THIS WARRANTY?

This Warranty does not apply to any non-STANDDESK branded hardware products or any software, even if packaged or sold with STANDDESK hardware. Manufacturers, suppliers, or publishers, other than STANDDESK, may provide their own warranties to you – please contact them for further information. STANDDESK is not responsible for damage arising from failure to follow instructions relating to the STANDDESK Product's use.
